Report Sections

- 1. Executive Summary
- 2. Introduction of company
 - a. Should include business line, strategy, estimated financials, and headcount
- 3. Description of working group and function
 - a. E.g., design engineering, programming; provide capital equipment design for manufacturing plants
- 4. Role and activities during the summer
 - a. Training provided and what self-provided training/learning was necessary
 - b. Overall goals for the employment period
 - c. If and how those goals were achieved
 - d. Detailed description of what was done during the employment period
 - i. This should include any documentation of technical work that is appropriate (CAD model screen shots; lines of code)
 - ii. This should be the bulk of your report and very detailed
 - e. Lessons learned during the employment period
- 5. Your education and your employment
 - a. How your education prepared you for this employment opportunity
 - i. What were you glad that you knew
 - ii. What do you wish you had known
 - b. What did you learn about engineering that you didn't previously know

Additional Questions (Choose 2 ~250 words each)

- 1. List one course or topic that you are excited to learn more about as a result of your employment and explain why.
- 2. Compare and contrast what working as a technical professional was like to what you expected.
- 3. Examine a job that you would like to have in 5-10 years at that employer and discuss how you think you would get there.
- 4. Write a persuasive essay to recruit one of your classmates to take a position at your employer.
